Soul Dog Rescue ("SDR" or "Rescue"), is a Colorado non-profit corporation with an IRS 501(c)(3) designation. SDR's main charitable purpose is providing free or low-cost sterilization of cats and dogs, primarily on Indian Reservations. Therefore, the majority of SDR's rescued pets are obtained from the Tribal Lands in the Four Corners area while SDR is performing spay/neuter clinics. This includes the Navajo Nation, Ute Mountain and Hopi Lands. These pets are considered "Rez" (Reservation) pets. SDR often pulls many of these animals from animal control/local pound before euthanasia, or finds them on the side of roads, dumped at gas stations or grocery stores or obtains them from individuals with too many animals or they are surrendered at the clinics. SDR typically does not have much background information on the animals it rescues. Rez animals' lives are often very rough, with lack of regular food and water, lack of access to veterinary care, including basic vaccinations, and a harsh environment, usually having lived outdoors their entire lives. Many Rez animals may have had ticks and/or fleas, internal parasites, ringworm, ear mites and other zoonotic conditions. SDR ensures each animal receives veterinary care and examination, treatment of known or common health issues (such as parasites), age appropriate vaccinations and sterilization prior to adoption. Each adopter will be provided with veterinary records for treatment provided while the animal was cared for by SDR.

## **ADOPTION AGREEMENT**

Soul Dog Rescue ("SDR" or "Rescue"), a Colorado non-profit corporation agrees to transfer ownership and possession of the pet identified above (hereinafter "Pet") in exchange for the payment and promises in this agreement by the undersigned (Adopter). The parties intend to be legally bound by this Agreement for the life of the pet. I, the Adopter, show my agreement to the following by placing my initials in front of each item:

Please take all veterinary records to your appointment and let to know you have just adopted a dog from SDR when making your appointment. SDR will cover to following: a physical examination; medications to treat upper respiratory infections (colds) and/or treatment for diarrhea and/or vomiting; treatment of urinary tract infections; treatment of ear, eye and SDR will not be responsible for treatment of traumatic injuries, congenital issues, ancillary proceed dental work, heartworm testing and treatment, or other problems. The veterinarian may recovaccines, tests or treatments that are not covered by SDR but are the responsibility of the adopter. 6 I agree to provide the pet with the necessary vaccinations and provide all necessary medical treatments as advised by my veterinarian. I agree to obtain immediate veterinary care should the pet become sick or injured, and to take full financial responsibility for such veterinary expenses.
I agree Pet will be kept as an indoor pet, and agree to allow it full access to my home. I agree to provide the pet with fresh water, wholesome food, adequate exercise, and affection. Canines: I agree that I currently and will always have and maintain a fenced yard at the home where Pet will be or I understand that I must demonstrate to Rescue an ability to properly exercise and keep Pet safe while going to the bathroom. Canines and Felines: I agree to not allow Pet to ever be allowed to run loose in an unfenced area. I agree not to tie up or chain the pet or to allow it to ride uncaged in the back of a pick-up truck or open vehicle. I agree to comply with local and state statutes and ordinances, including licensing and leash laws. I will not allow the pet to roam or run at large. Felines: I will not let my Pet outside unless on a properly fitting harness that the Pet cannot wriggle out of that is on a leash held by a responsible adult or in a fully enclosed outdoor area (i.e. "cattio").
8If the pet is a cat, I agree NOT to declaw the cat under any circumstances, understanding that declawing is the painful amputation of the first knuckle, which renders the pet defenseless and inflicts unnecessary pain. If the pet is a dog, I agree not to debark, defang, or crop the ears or tail of the dog under any circumstances.
9I will not abuse or neglect the Pet or allow it to be abused or neglected. I authorize Rescue, at its sole discretion, to determine whether or not Pet has been abused or neglected while in my possession and to declare this agreement in breach and reclaim the pet.
10I will not use a choke-type collar, prong collar or shock collar at any time. I will attach <b>personal identification</b> tag to a non-choke collar to be worn at all times.
11Pet's microchip will have the Rescue's contact information (address, phone number, or email address). I agree to register my contact information with the microchip provider within 1 week of adoption. I agree not to remove or alter Rescue's contact information from Pet's microchip. In the event the microchip stops working (backs out after implantation, microchip cannot be found with microchip scanner) I agree to notify Rescue without delay so that a new microchip can be implanted.
In the event Pet becomes lost; I will immediately notify Rescue. I will immediately notify the Rescue of any change of contact information (address, phone number(s), or email address). I authorize any individual or agency to release the pet back to SDR if the pet is found abandoned, running at large or is brought to a shelter facility for any reason. I understand that Rescue may not return Pet to my care if Pet became lost or impounded through a breach of this agreement.
13Pet shall not participate or be trained as a guard dog or fighting dog, nor will I use it for any purpose other than companionship. I will not allow any physical, mental, or emotional abuse of the Pet.
14I <u>will not</u> leave Pet unattended with small children.
15I affirm that no member of my household has been convicted or charged with any animal welfare law violation such as hoarding, unsanitary conditions, neglect, cruelty, abandonment, etc. I affirm that no member of my household has been convicted or charged with any domestic battery or sex crime.
16 I affirm that if I rent, I have the permission of my landlord to adopt this Pet. I agree to pay any pet deposit or pet rent required to keep my pet.
17 I affirm that all of the members of my household agree with the decision to adopt Pet and will treat Pet as a family member.
18I will ensure compliance with all applicable local ordinances and state statutes regarding ownership of Pet. If I am charged with violating any such ordinance or statute while in possession of Pet, I understand that Rescue is not responsible for obtaining legal counsel for me or for paying any fines or penalties assessed. However, in the event local animal control is seeking surrender or destruction of Pet, I agree to contact Rescue immediately to discuss surrendering the Pet back to Rescue.
19I am taking possession of Pet at my own risk and I release Rescue, its officers, directors, members,

and all actions, causes of action, suits, debts, dues, accounts, covenants, agreements, judgements, claims and demand of any nature whatsoever arising out of my adoption of Pet from Rescue.
20 I agree Rescue will not be held liable for any damage or loss resulting from the failure of Pet to respond to any commands taught to Pet or resulting from counseling advice supplied to Adopter. In the event any behavioral concerns arise, Adopter will immediately notify Rescue. Should any behavior of Pet result in damage to property, Adopter, or another person or animal while in the possession of Adopter, Adopter agrees to assume full liability to such third party for any and all such damage, and to absolve Rescue from any and all obligations to pay such damage to third party.
21I agree Rescue shall not be responsible for any bodily injuries or property damage and/or damage to other animals caused by Pet or by the actions of Adopter. The Adopter hereby specifically assumes sole responsibility for, and agrees to indemnify and hold Rescue harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of liability imposed by law upon the Rescue or any of its officers, directors, members, employees, representatives, agents, or assigns because of bodily injuries or death to any person or persons including Adopter or those in Adopter's household, or any damage to property and/or animals arising out of or in consequence of the placement of Pet howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property and/or animals may be caused, whether or not the same may have been caused, or may be alleged to have been accused, by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their directors, members, employees, representatives, agents, or assigns or any other person.
22I acknowledge and agree that animal bites or other injuries to humans and other animals do occur and that all animals can carry and transmit parasites, diseases, including zoonotic diseases that can be transferred from animals to humans. I understand that Rescue will not be responsible for the transmission or transfer of any disease or parasite to other animals or people in the adopting household and no attempt will be made by me or anyone on my behalf to hold Rescue responsible.
23 I agree to allow SDR to conduct a home visit. I represent to SDR that my home is a safe, clean environment for Pet. In the event the home is deemed unsuitable for Pet, I understand that this is a material breach of the agreement and I agree to surrender the pet to SDR.
24 I acknowledge that SDR makes a lifetime commitment to any pet it has adopted. Failure to comply with any of the adoption contract requirements constitutes grounds for SDR to deem this contract in breach and reclaim the adopted pet. SDR will provide Adopter of written notice to his/her last known address in the event it believes any term or condition of this Agreement has been breached. I agree to voluntarily surrender the pet to SDR upon receipt of such notice, making no charges of any nature for licensing, care, food, or any other services.
25 I agree that any legal action pertaining to this agreement shall be heard in Arapahoe County Court (or its small claims division), Colorado. In the event Rescue has to file a replevin action to recover possession of Pet, I voluntarily waive my right to attend a show cause hearing under Colorado Rule of Civil Procedure 411 and agree that the Court has the authority to issue a pre-judgement order of possession of Pet to the Rescue without the necessity of posting a bond.
26 I acknowledge that breach of this agreement will result in travel costs, court costs and attorney fees payable by me if legal action or travel is necessary for Rescue to recover Pet. I understands that Pet has intrinsic value and is not replaceable, so if Pet is altered in any way prohibited by Paragraph 8, euthanized, lost or otherwise unable to be returned to the Rescue due to the negligence or intent of Adopter to circumvent Rescue's right to re-possess Pet, I will be in breach of this agreement and will be subject to pay liquidated damages to the Rescue in the amount of \$2,500.00 in addition to all attorney's fees and costs and actual damages incurred as a result of the breach.
27 I acknowledge SDR shall be entitled to all attorney fees and costs incurred in any legal action brought by either party as a result of my adoption of Pet or any alleged breach of any of the terms of this agreement.
28I understand that by voluntarily signing this agreement, I am entering into a legal and binding contract with Rescue. I understand that any misrepresentations in my application or failure to abide by any of the terms of this agreement are cause for Rescue to declare this agreement in breach and notify me of its intention to reclaim Pet.
